Fees

The indicative fee for processing a *Manufacturer prototype vehicle application* is \$184. This is based on the hourly rate of \$184 per hour (including GST) and has to be paid before Waka Kotahi starts work on the application.

Circumstances include the complexity of the issue, uniqueness of the application or whether the investigations or analysis involved with the application has already been largely completed as part of a previous application.

Waka Kotahi will advise the applicant if the fee for processing the exemption is going to be more than the indicative fee.
