

When to use this form

Use this form when (tick applicable):

- a vehicle is imported into New Zealand by an immigrant entitled to take up residence in New Zealand under the Immigration Act 1987, **or**
- a vehicle is imported to New Zealand by a New Zealand citizen or resident returning to New Zealand after at least 21 months overseas.

Privacy

All information contained in your application form will be held by the Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency (and its agents) and treated as confidential subject to the Official Information Act 1982 and the Privacy Act 1993. Fees and payment

The fee for processing an *Application for identification of an immigrants' vehicle* is \$184 (including GST). The agent processing the application will collect the fee.

Required documentation

You must include these documents with your application.

Please check to ensure each one is attached.

- Proof of title (overseas registration papers in the owner's name)
- Proof of importation (bill of lading, shipping or insurance documents in the importer's name)
- Proof of purchase date (purchase receipt, bill of sale or similar in importer's name)
Note: Only required if the period of ownership cannot be verified by other documentation.
- Proof of ownership for at least one year overseas (eg, airline tickets, hotel bookings, immigration visa, etc)
- Proof of New Zealand citizenship or residency, or entitlement to take up permanent residence in New Zealand

Declaration

I declare that:

- I lived outside New Zealand for at least 21 months before arriving in/returning to New Zealand, and
- I personally owned the vehicle, and registered it for personal use in a country outside New Zealand for at least one year before arriving in/returning to New Zealand, and
- I am not importing the vehicle on behalf of, or for, a third party, and
- I will retain ownership of the vehicle for at least one year after the date that the vehicle is first registered in New Zealand, and
- I have not imported any other vehicle as an immigrant's vehicle, and
- I will not sell or lease the vehicle to a third party for at least one year after the date on which the vehicle is first registered in New Zealand, and
- the vehicle will not be operated in a transport service for at least one year after the date on which the vehicle is first registered in New Zealand.
