

Use this form to apply for a special interest vehicle permit for a class MA vehicle, under 20 years of age, which doesn't meet at least one of these vehicle standards:

- Frontal impact standard requirements under clause 2.1 of the Land Transport Rule: Frontal Impact 2001.
- Vehicle exhaust emission standard requirements under clause 2.2 of the Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Exhaust Emissions 2007.
- Electronic stability control requirements under clause 2.1(4) of the Land Transport Rule: Light Vehicle Brakes 2002.

Important information

- NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) grants a maximum of 200 special interest vehicles in any one year.
- A special interest vehicle must be border inspected and/or certified for entry into service in New Zealand no later than 6 months after the issue date of a special interest vehicle permit.
- You can't use a special interest vehicle permit to avoid the Clean Car Standard.

Before you apply for a permit, you should consider the following factors:

- The matters to be considered before a permit can be granted are set out in law. This means permits are not automatically granted.
- A permit cannot be granted to a vehicle that meets the required standards above.
- A permit cannot be issued to a vehicle that is over 20 years of age.
- The application cannot be submitted if the vehicle has been entry certified and recorded as entry compliant.
- The law does not provide for a permit to be granted on the basis of inconvenience or hardship.
- The fee is non-refundable, regardless of whether your application is granted or declined. It covers the cost of processing your application.
- NZTA is not obliged to grant a permit if it's not considered appropriate to do so.
- NZTA may impose conditions to any permits issued.

Fees and payment

The fee for processing an *Application for special interest vehicle permit* is \$23.20. We won't start work on the application until this is paid.

We'll send you an invoice with payment details and instructions. Payment must be made by the due date or the application will be returned to you as incomplete.

A special interest vehicle must:

- a) be owned as a collector's item (as determined by NZTA), and
- b) be of historic value, or
- c) meet three of the following four criteria:
 - The vehicle is and was manufactured as a two-door coupe or convertible
(you must supply evidence with this application)
 - The vehicle is and was manufactured as a high performance vehicle
(you must supply evidence with this application)
 - The vehicle's make and model has been (or was) manufactured in annual volumes of 20,000 units or less
(you must supply evidence with this application)
 - The vehicle (or its make, model and sub-model) is identified as a collector's item in one of the following magazines, or the respective website
(you must supply a copy of the relevant article with this application)
 - *Australian Classic Car*
 - *Car and Driver* (US)
 - *Automobile* (US)
 - *MOTOR* (Australia)
 - *Motor Trend* (US)
 - *New Zealand Autocar*
 - *Road and Track* (US)
 - *Top Gear* (UK)
 - *Top Gear NZ*
 - *Unique Cars* (Australia)
 - *WHEELS* (Australia)
 - *New Zealand Classic Car*

Required documentation

You must include these documents with your application. Please check each one is attached.

- Proof of title (*for example, overseas registration papers in the owner's name*)
- Proof the owner has another class MA, MB, MC or NA vehicle for primary use (*ie registered in the owner's name, leased in the owner's name, or a company car*)
- Proof that the vehicle meets required special interest vehicle criteria
- Proof of New Zealand citizenship or residency
- Evidence of current exhaust emission standard

- c) I have not been granted another special interest vehicle permit within the last two years, and

- f) the vehicle will not be operated in a transport service
