The 10 March 2025 VIRM amendments are now in effect.

- that allow for the use of electronic check sheets
- that allow for the recording of the WoF label serial number on the electronic check sheet
- to remove ambiguity between certifications carried out prior to 2005 and those that now require certification from 1 January 2025
- to include the updated New Zealand Standard 5446: 2024 - On-road heavy vehicle towing connections - Drawbeams and drawbars.
