## 2-4 Cylinder attachment

### Reason for rejection

#### Condition

1. The security of the container attachment has been affected or weakened by:
  - a) rust, corrosion, abrasion or impact damage, or
  - b) loose nuts, worn or stretched bolts, or
  - c) loose bands, wear under bands, incompatible band materials, or
  - d) cracks or metal fatigue.

### Summary of legislation

#### Applicable legislation

- AS/NZS 2739: 2003, section 6.9.

#### Condition

1. A cylinder attachment must not have any of the following conditions such that the security of the attachment is at risk:
  - a) rust, corrosion, abrasion or impact damage
  - b) loose nuts, worn or stretched bolts
  - c) loose bands, wear under bands, incompatible band materials
  - d) cracks or metal fatigue.
