It took effect from 19 December 2023. This amendment is to officially incorporate the advice into the VIRM.</p> <p>Wheelchair stowing device letter to WoF and CoF IOs – 19 December 2023</p>
4-2 Front and rear fog lamps	Aligning fog lamp requirements with headlamps, especially around LED conversion kits.
